1. GMAT CLASSIC COURSE

- Class Times: Weekend; Evening; Day
- Course duration: 56.5 hours
- 39 hours classroom lessons
- 2 x 3-hour lessons per week
- No of weeks: 6
- 5 full tests
- Maximum class size: 12 students
- Course fee: 31,000 Baht
- Guaranteed score improvement: 50 points

GMAT CLASSIC COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enter the GMAT Classic course you need to score a minimum 15 in the GMAT verbal and GMAT math practice test and a combined minimum score of 350 points.

If you have this score, check out our weekend, evening and daytime GMAT classes on our website www.princetonreviewthailand.com and call our office to enroll.

You will need to present a printout of your Princeton Review practice test score, or a real GMAT test report when you enroll.

If your score is below this number you are probably not ready to take the GMAT yet. Ask for a free counseling appointment with our Director, or one of our GMAT experts, who can help you to create a study plan to boost your English before taking the GMAT.

2. GMAT EXECUTIVE - for high scoring students aiming for top scores

- Class Times: Weekend afternoons
- Course duration: 58 hours
- 39 hours classroom lessons
- 2 x 3-hour lessons per week
- No of weeks: 6
- 5 full tests
- Maximum class size: 8 students
- Course fee: 33,000 Baht
- Guaranteed score improvement: 50 points, average for high scoring student is 92 points*

GMAT EXECUTIVE COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enter the GMAT EXECUTIVE course the minimum practice test criteria we accept are a score of 20 in the GMAT verbal and 30 in the GMAT math practice test, with a combined minimum score of 500 points.

Applicants for this course will be asked to take an additional timed essay and have a short interview at the Princeton Review office.

If you have this minimum score, call our office to enroll.

You will need to present a printout of your Princeton Review practice test score, or a real GMAT test report when you enroll.

3. GMAT VERBAL EXTRA PRACTICE

4. GMAT ADVANCED PRACTICE

- 6 hours Math, 6 hours Verbal
- 2 x 3-hour lessons per weekend
- No of weeks: 2
- Maximum class size: 15 students
- Course fee: 9,500 Baht

GMAT ADVANCED PRACTICE COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This course is only available to students who have already completed a GMAT Classic course or a GMAT Executive course. It is for students who want a few hours extra practice in both test sections.
